1. RTC attrition is broken down into two types. RTC Connected Attrition and Pre-Service attrition.  
Categories of attrition:
  - a. Legal
  - b. Medical
  - c. Psych
  - d. Other
2. Reasons for Attrition:
  - a. Drugs- illegal drug usage
  - b. Medical:
    - 1) Pre-Service- Neurology, Ophthalmology/Optometry, Orthopedic, Internal Medicine, Podiatry, Dermatology, Ear, Nose, Throat.
    - 2) RTC Connected- Orthopedic, Internal Medicine, Podiatry, Urology.
