1. Purpose. To promulgate command policies and procedures for the nomination, selection, and recognition of command Sailors for Junior/Senior Sailor of the Quarter/Year (JSOQ/JSOY and SSOQ/SSOY) per reference (a) and utilizing enclosures (1) through (5).

2. Cancellation. NAVCRUITDISTNYINST 1700.3E

3. Discussion. The JSOQ/SSOQ and the JSOY/SSOY programs are designed to recognize the very best Navy Recruiting District New York (NRD NY) Sailors. Reference (a) will be used as a guide for all nominations. Sailors who have excelled in demanding and challenging assignments will be nominated. Particular emphasis should be placed on sustained superior performance, leadership, self-improvement, command and community involvement, and professional achievement. SSOY selections will compete for NRC, Navy Region East SSOY. This program will run on a fiscal year schedule from 1 October to 30 September. The SOY/JSOY selection must be completed prior to 1 November.

4. Categories/Eligibility

a. The JSOQ/Y is open to all eligible Active, Full-Time Support and Reserve Third Class and Second Class Petty Officers. SSOQ/Y is open to all eligible First Class Petty Officers. Nominees for SOQ and SOY must have served onboard NRD NY for a minimum of six to nine months respectively by the end of the quarter/year. Nominees for JSOQ/SSOQ in a frocked status may compete at either the higher or lower level, depending on how long they have been in a frocked status.

b. Nominees must meet height/weight requirements and have passed the most recent Physical Fitness Assessment (PFA). Sailors medically waived or assigned to the Fitness Enhancement Program (FEP) are eligible for competition, but the candidates must have passed the most recent official PFA subsequent to their assignment to the FEP and meet body composition standards. Candidates must not have any documented Non-Judicial Punishment in the last 24 months. All JSOQ/SSOQ selectees will be nominated for JSOY/SSOY respectively, together with up to three other candidates as selected by the Division Supervisors, Chief Recruiter (CR) and Command Master Chief (CMC).

c. The following Sailors are ineligible to compete:

(1) Sailors selected for advancement to Chief Petty Officer or Commissioning (unless formal declination is approved).

(2) Canvasser Recruiters or Support Personnel eligible for Enlisted Recruiter of the Year.

5. Responsibilities

a. The Commanding Officer (CO) is responsible for monitoring the SOY and SOQ programs.

b. The CMC will serve as the Program Manager and will appoint and maintain direct oversight over the Command Coordinator.

c. The Command Coordinator will:

(1) Ensure selection of a Board Chairperson and members for each review board are approved by the CMC.

(2) Provide nomination packages to board members.

(3) Publish time, place and interview schedule for review boards using enclosure (4).

(4) Assign topic questions to selected board members.

(5) Serve as the recorder for the NRD NY boards.

(6) Forward soft award copies to the Administrative Officer (AO).

d. The Board Chairperson will:

(1) Brief board members on conduct and processes of the board.

(2) Select the best candidate ensuring there is board consensus on the final recommendation to the chain-of-command. Coordinate the minutes of the board and keep all votes for the year.

e. The Board members will use enclosure (5) to objectively evaluate candidates on the merits of their nomination package, appearance before the board and knowledge of the material selected by the board.

f. The AO is responsible for formatting the drafted awards.

g. The Public Affairs Officer is responsible for the pictures, picture board, and Website entries of the winners.

6. Selection Boards

a. All selection boards will consist of a representative from each Division/Support element. The board structure will be as follows:

(1) SSOQ/Y

(a) Chairman - CMC

(b) Board Members - Selected Chief Petty Officers

(2) JSOQ/Y

(a) Chairman - First Class Petty Officer Association (FCPOA) President

(b) Board Members - Selected First Class Petty Officers

b. Each board member will have one vote, with the Chairman voting only in the event of a tie.

c. The JSOQ/Y Chairman will, immediately upon completion of the board, forward individual grading sheets to the CMC for final tally.

d. Board participants WILL NOT reveal board proceedings or results to anyone external to the board. Board selections serve ONLY as recommendations to the NRD NY CO.

e. Selection recommendations will be forwarded through the CMC to the CO for final approval.

7. Awards/Recognition

a. NRD NY JSOQ/SSOQ will receive:

- (1) NRD CO Letter of Commendation
- (2) Commemorative plaque
- (3) 3-Day Special Liberty
- (4) Photograph displayed on the HQ Picture Board
- (5) Command coin presented by the CO

b. NRD NY JSOY/SSOY will receive:

(1) Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal. Presentation of the SOY award will only occur after non-selection as NRC Region East SOY

- (2) Commemorative plaque
- (3) Nomination for the Region/NRC SOY competition (SSOY only)
- (4) 4-Day Special Liberty
- (5) Photograph displayed on the HQ Picture Board
- (6) Command coin presented by the CO

8. Action

a. Division (LCPO)/Support CPOs will prepare nomination packages and submit a copy of the nomination package to the Command Coordinator in advance of Board convening date.

b. Each Division/Support element may submit one candidate per category. Nomination packages will be submitted to the CMC via the Command Coordinator. All supervisors are encouraged to hold oral selection boards when choosing a candidate. This not only prepares candidates for command-level competition, but also exposes more Sailors to the process. Deadlines to submit nomination packages


for SOQ will be 1600 on the 15th of December, March, June and September unless modified by the CMC or Command Coordinator. The SOY package and board dates may change as affected by Region/NRC schedules.

c. The CMC and Command Coordinator will ensure SOQ selection recommendations are made to the CO at least three days prior to All Hands the first month of each quarter.

d. Use the format contained in enclosures (1) through (3), as appropriate, to prepare nomination packages. Include accomplishments that occurred or were awarded within applicable reporting period only.

9. Review. The Command Coordinator will review and update this instruction annually.
