Subj: MORALE, WELFARE AND RECREATION (MWR) ADVISORY COUNCIL

Ref: (a) OPNAVINST 1710.11

1. Purpose. To establish policy and procedures for Morale, Welfare and Recreation (MWR) Advisory Council and direct adherence to reference (a).

2. Cancellation. NAVCRUITDISTOHIOINST 1710.1B.

3. Action

a. The MWR Advisory Council members will be appointed by the Commanding Officer for a one year term lasting from the annual awards banquet through a review of the next awards banquet. Members may be reassigned to this council or new council members may be chosen who will be on board for the duration of the assignment.

b. The council shall serve without financial compensation.

c. Each Division Leading Chief Petty Officer and Headquarters will nominate a military representative who will comprise the voting membership of the council. Division Social Coordinators will be invited to participate as non-voting members. The MWR Funds Custodian will also be a non-voting member.

d. The Chair shall:

(1) Convene quarterly council meetings and forward recommendations in the form of minutes, for the Commanding Officer's approval.

(2) Plan and execute a review of the past year's MWR program the weekend of the annual awards banquet. This review meeting will be attended by both the current and next year's councils.

(3) Forward the current fiscal year expenditure plan with opinions and recommendations of the council for the Commanding Officer's approval.

(4) Direct and manage the advisory council in the preparation of a proposed expenditure plan for the following year's council.
