
1. Purpose. To establish Navy Recruiting District Ohio's policies on Driving Under the Influence (DUI) and Driving While Intoxicated (DWI).

2. Discussion. Drug and Alcohol Abuse Prevention, Navy's policy on DUI/DWI, personal responsibilities and address avenues for corrective actions.

3. Policy. NAVCRUITDISTOHIO Policy on DUI/DWI is provided in enclosure (1).

4. Action. Command Drug and Alcohol Program Advisor (DAPA) is overall responsible for tracking and compliance of 100% acknowledged Page 13s for the entire command. Department Heads will familiarize themselves with references (a) through (d) and ensure all military personnel are apprised of the contents of enclosure (1) and sign enclosure (2). Enclosure (1) is to be retained in all offices/work centers and enclosure (2) will be forwarded to Admin for entry into the junk jacket.

5. Cancellation Contingency. This notice is canceled upon reissue of a superseding notice of the same subject.

**COMMANDING OFFICER, NAVY RECRUITING DISTRICT OHIO
POLICY STATEMENT ON DRIVING UNDER THE INFLUENCE AND
DRIVING WHILE INTOXICATED**

A striking majority of Navy disciplinary and personnel readiness problems are related to alcohol abuse. One of the most serious forms is Driving Under the Influence (DUI) and Driving While Intoxicated (DWI).

I consider a drunk driving violation to be a failure in judgment, behavior, leadership, a lack of personal responsibility and a general disregard for the safety of yourself and our community.

DUI/DWI is incompatible with the Navy Core Values, standards of conduct and NRD Ohio's Commanding Officer's policies. If you are convicted by a military or civilian court of DUI/DWI or any alcohol related charges, appropriate disciplinary action will be taken and documented in your service record by NAVPERS 1070/613, evaluation and/or fitness report. Production Recruiter's will have their 9585 NEC revoked and receive a Fault Transfer. Military personnel assigned to Navy Recruiting District Ohio are responsible for ensuring they take personal responsibility to ensure they do not drive under the influence or when intoxicated.

Members who report DUI/DWI incidents shall not be subjected to reprisal. Any incidents of reprisal should be immediately reported to the chain of command and will be dealt with promptly. Reprisal, in any form, will not be tolerated.
