## **GENEROUS EDUCATIONAL INCENTIVES AVAILABLE**

Wherever you are in your dental career, the Navy can help you attain your goals with generous scholarships, financial assistance and continued education programs.





# AS A DENTAL RESIDENT:

## **Financial Assistance Program (FAP):**

Provides doctors in residency training a monthly stipend over \$2,300.00\* and an annual grant of \$45,000 while in your residency. Following residency, you would become an active duty service member. Participants incur a year-for-year active duty service obligation, 2-year minimum.

Training in Medical Specialty (TMS) is a Navy Reserve (SELRES DCO) program designed to provide financial and other incentives for professionals while in select Dental residency and fellowship programs (Oral Maxillofacial Surgery). Service Obligation depends on the monetary funding that you choose.

## **FOR EXAMPLE:**

### **TMS with no Stipend or Long Repayment:**

3-year obligation.

### **TMS + Monthly Stipend:**

1 year for every 6 months stipend is received; minimum 3 years.

### **TMS + Stipend + Loan Repayment:**

1 year for every 6 months stipend is received; minimum 3 years; loan repayment is paid after each successful year.

## **AS A DENTAL STUDENT:**


### **Health Professional Scholarship Program (HPSP):**

Covers 100% of dental school tuition – plus offers a monthly allowance over \$2,300.00\* to cover living expenses for up to four years. And, on top of that, you could qualify for a sign on bonus of up to \$20,000.

### **Health Services Collegiate Program (HSCP):**

Provides anywhere from \$157,000 to \$269,000\* during dental school. This includes a monthly salary – plus a housing allowance for up to 48 months (exact amount based on cost of living in the school location).

*\* Monetary amounts are subject to change and depend on medical specialty, service commitment agreement and locality cost of living changes. See your Navy Medical recruiter for details.*
