
CAREER OPPORTUNITIES INCLUDE:

- ▶ **AG (Aerographers's Mate):** Meteorological and oceanographic data analyst; interprets satellite data, radar imagery, and environmental data. Maintains sensitive equipment, provides real-time and predictive warnings of hazardous weather and sea conditions.
- ▶ **CTR (Collection):** Analyst, Technical Report Writer, Computer Security Specialist, Radiotelegraphic Operator, and Electronic Intel Operations Specialist.
- ▶ **CTT (Technical):** Electronic Intelligence Specialist, Computer Operations, and Signals Analyst.
- ▶ **CTM (Maintenance):** Data Communications Analyst, Computer Security, Station Installer and Repairer, Data Communications Technician, Field Service Engineer.
- ▶ **CTN (Networking):** Network Security, Network Engineer, Network Administration, and Network Exploitation.
- ▶ **CTI (Interpretive):** Work with classified material translating, interpreting, and transcribing foreign language communications data with state-of-the art equipment.
- ▶ **IS (Intelligence Specialist):** Analyze information, prepare and present briefings for operational missions, maintain intelligence databases, libraries and files.
- ▶ **IT (Information Systems Technician):** Apply technical expertise to the implementation, monitoring and maintenance of IT systems. Focus areas include network, systems and database administration, information assurance and more.

In their civilian lives, they are IT professionals, consultants and educators. Yet as Navy Reservists, they are expanding their horizons and playing a vital role in our nation's defense.




