THE NAVY AND NAVY RESERVE CONSTRUCTION BATTALIONS

America's Navy and Navy Reserve Construction Battalions – the Seabees – provide military construction support to Navy, Marine Corps, and other forces during military operations. They construct base facilities and conduct defensive operations as well. Seabees conduct specialized construction operations such as water well drilling, build runways and conduct battle damage repair. In addition to standard steel, wood, masonry and concrete construction, Seabees work and defend themselves while building facilities outside of their base camps. In times of disaster or emergency, Seabees are often among the first responders, ready to help restore necessary services and shelter. Seabees also conduct disaster control and recovery operations at home and around the world.

SEABEES OPPORTUNITIES:

-  **Builder (BU):** Construction of wooden, masonry and concrete structures, as well as interior finishing work.
-  **Construction Electrician (CE):** Install electrical and telephone networks; splice and lay wire and cable, and install, operate and repair generators, motors, transformers and lighting fixtures.
-  **Construction Mechanic (CM):** Repair vehicles, construction equipment. They also perform engine and auto body repair work.
-  **Engineering Aide (EA):** Draw plans; sketch, map and survey land for construction; estimate material requirements; and test materials.
-  **Equipment Operator (EO):** Operation of heavy-duty construction equipment, including bulldozers and scrapers.
-  **Steelworker (SW):** Weld and form steel and construct sheet-metal structures.
-  **Utilitiesman (UT):** Plumbing installation, water purification, boiler operation, ventilator system repair, and refrigeration and air conditioning maintenance.
