ELIGIBILITY

To qualify for the CANREC program, whether officer or enlisted you must:

- Be a Ready Reservist at the time of recall (at least 31 days from your last release from Active Duty)
- Meet physical requirements for recall
- Be eligible for Permanent Change of Station (PCS) orders (preference will be given to applicants residing within the local commuting area)
- Be able to complete 20 years of active duty before reaching age 55 (enlisted)
- Be in permanent pay grade E-4 or E-5 at the time of your recall
- Officer applicants must be LT/0-3 or below and not in a Failed of Selection (FOS) status or previously released from Active Duty as a result of FOS.

Application Process:

Applications should be made to Navy Personnel Command through the appropriate chain of command. The processing time for a typical application, once received, is approximately 21-30 days. For more information contact your local Navy Reserve Recruiter at your NOSC.
