How to Join and Make the Most of Chamber Membership

1. Research your local Chambers of Commerce and their programs and community involvement..
2. Request a membership packet, which should include a list of membership dues, networking opportunities, benefits, and a full membership list.
3. Connect with current Chamber members and inquire about their experiences.
4. Schedule time to meet with your Chamber of Commerce's membership director to look over membership levels and payment plans. Be sure to inquire about military membership rates
5. Appoint a chamber representative to attend regular seminars and events. There are various networking and learning opportunities which are two big reasons to join the Chamber. Attend free programs put on by the Chamber to meet other businesses and to learn new skills.
