- The Navy is the most highly skilled, technologically advanced military force in the world.
- Conquering the world's oceans has been a defining challenge of mankind – a challenge that America's Navy has always embraced with bravery, ingenuity, and honor. Sailors are tested and shaped by the Navy/sea experience, becoming better versions of themselves.
- The Navy is the esteemed, smart force that pushes the boundaries of what is possible. It is prestigious, strategic, innovative, nurturing, and progressive.
- The Navy attracts seekers of knowledge and adventure, who are intelligent, adaptable, resourceful, ambitious, courageous, hardworking, and strong-willed.
- The Navy offers more than 60 career fields in leading-edge areas such as nuclear engineering, special warfare, cryptology, intelligence and information systems management. There are also enlisted career paths in fields that are not widely associated with the Navy, including music, journalism, culinary arts, marketing and law enforcement. There's even a way to represent the Navy as an esports athlete.
- The Navy has SEALs, Explosive Ordnance Disposal experts, Divers, and Rescue Swimmers. If Special Operations interests you, they are looking for people to fill these jobs.
- The Navy is the only branch of the service that utilizes nuclear power. The Navy can teach you to be a Nuclear Engineer, trained to run the power plants that propel the submarines and aircraft carriers of the Fleet.
- There are more airplanes in the Navy than the Air Force. If flying jets, propeller planes, and helicopters on and off ships is something that excites you, there is training to enable you to gain those skills.
- The Navy offers enlistment bonuses up to \$40,000, best-in-class training, accelerated promotion, and re-signing bonuses up to \$100,000, the highest in the U.S. military.
- The Navy has 51 major bases in the continental United States and Hawaii, as well as bases in Bahamas, Bahrain, El Salvador, Egypt, Cuba, Djibouti, Greece, Guam, Italy, Japan, Kuwait, Oman, Peru, Saudi Arabia, Singapore, South Korea, Spain, and the United Arab Emirates. No other military services provides greater opportunities to travel the country and world.
- The Navy is the only military branch to operate on, above, and below the water, as well as on land. The Navy is America's forward deployed force and is a major deterrent to aggression around the world.
- The Navy can engage in battles from miles away, while the Army faces conflicts at closer proximities.
- The Navy allows you to earn college education at their expense, paying nearly all of the tuition. When enlisted, you can attend classes even while on the ship. The Navy also offers world-class training, using cutting-edge equipment and technology, to prepare enlisted men and women to maximize their potential.
- The Navy offers a college fund for recruits who enlist in jobs the Navy considers understaffed, adding money to monthly G.I. Bill entitlements. The Navy also gives tuition assistance for college courses taken off duty.
- Navy personnel often earn higher salaries than they would anywhere else, which enables sailors to provide a higher level of financial support to their families.
